Faith Formation has been a good way to connect this demographic to the parish.</p> <p>Type of Effort: Building on past/current efforts in partnership with Sacred Heart in Monticello.</p> <p>Action Step: 1. Begin Faith Formation year with Holy Mass, including student & family 2. Resume youth liturgical ministries at Masses in October 2023 and February 2024</p> <p>Communication of Goal & Progress: Utilize Mass announcements, bulletin, Facebook, parish website. Encourage all parishioners to invite young adults/young families to celebrate Mass.</p>

Meeting regularly with good attendance. 2. Serve set terms and conducting annual elections. Resume leadership elections that have not taken place in 2 decades.</p> <p>Type of Effort: New initiative or effort</p> <p>Action Step: 1. Start with minimum of 2 Pastoral & Finance Council meeting 2. Set staggered terms for current Pastoral & Finance Council members with one going off and one elected each year.</p> <p>Communication of Goal & Progress: Personal invitation, Mass announcements, bulletin, Facebook, website</p>
